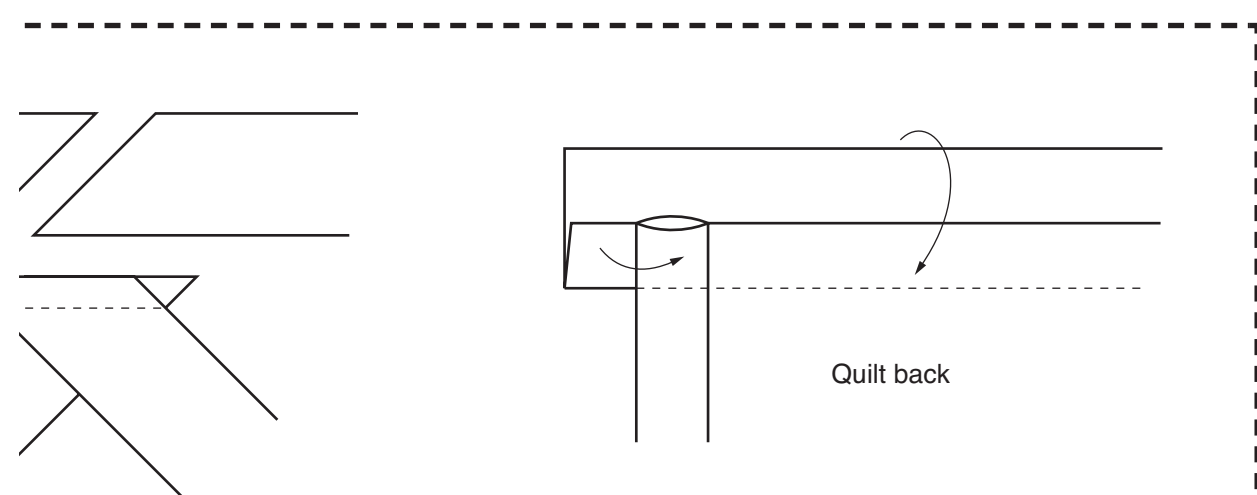
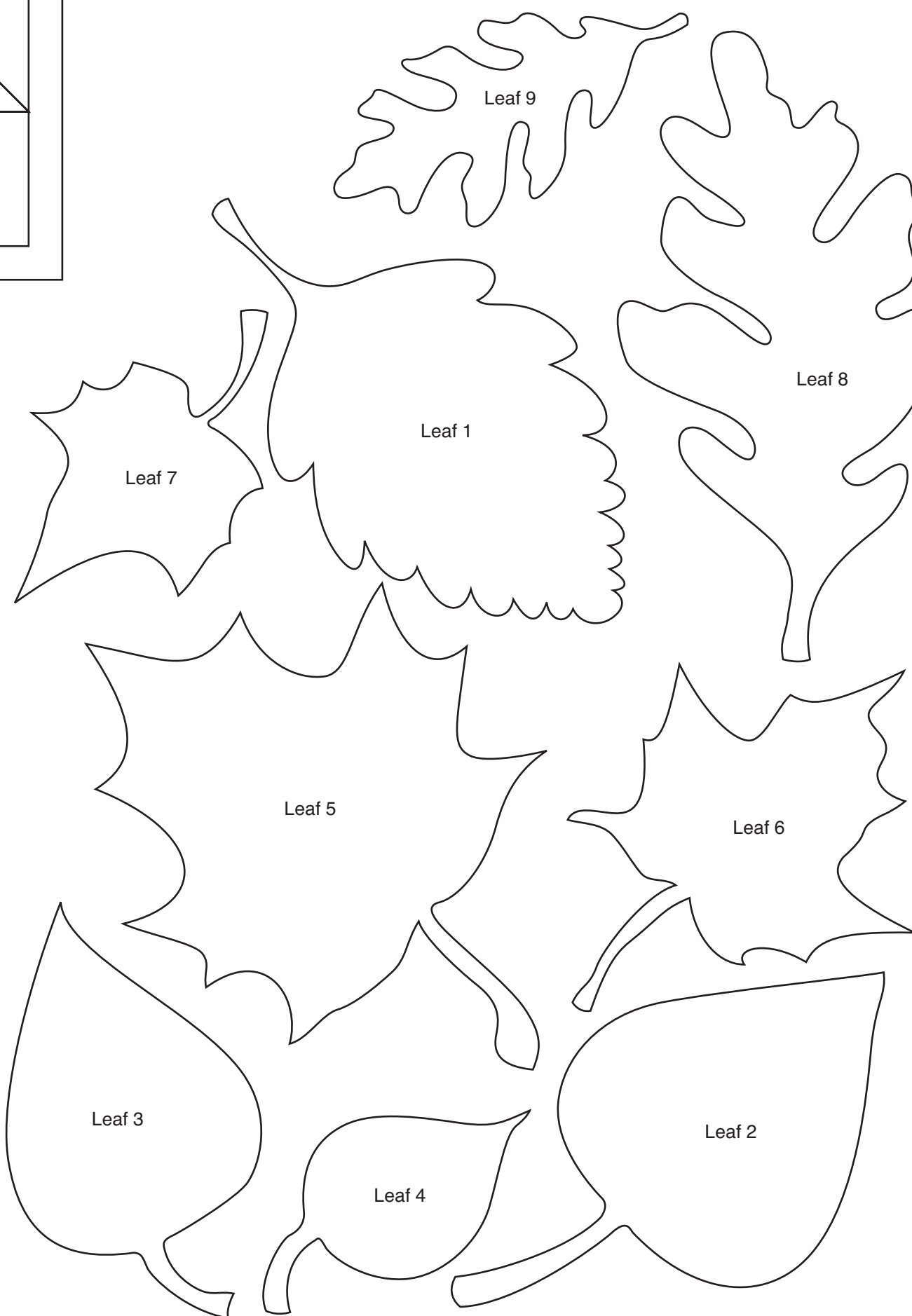

BUTTED CORNER (BELOW)

For a butted corner the first two sides match the quilt length, the last two sides are cut a little longer and then wrapped to the back as shown.

HOW TO MITRE A CORNER

a) Join the binding into one length with bias seams as shown above. Sew along one side stopping 1/4in from the corner.

b) Fold the fabric away from the corner

c) Fold back on itself in line with the next edge, start sewing from the corner.

d) Hand stitch to the back of your quilt and add a couple of stitches to the mitre too.
